The South Carolina Alliance of Children's Museums shares a commitment of enhancing the quality of life for the citizens of South Carolina and to promote education opportrunities for students across the state and to contribute to tourism development. Over 680,000 people visit 5 children's museums across the State each year, 35,000 of which are students on field trips. These museums are located in Richland, Horry, Charleston, Greenville, and Spartanburg Counties and welcome visitors from all 46 Counties. These funds will be used to enhance visitor safety and security to further protect our state's youngest citizens and their families when they visit these facilities. Examples of how these funds will be allocated include security cameras, staffing, secure entries and exits, safety planning and management, and upgraded alarm systems.
